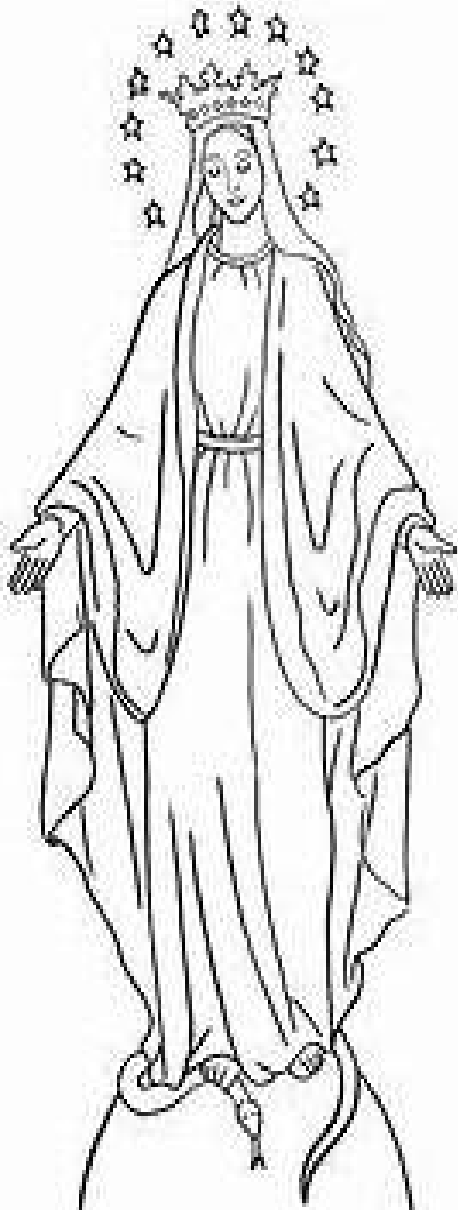

Mission Sunday – World Mission Sunday in 2019 falls on 20 October, today. Instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1926, the annual day encourages prayers, cooperation and help for missions as well as reminding Christians about the fundamental missionary character of the Church and of every baptized person. World Mission Sunday joins all Catholics of the world into one community of faith. At Mass, we recommit ourselves to our common vocation, through Baptism, to be missionaries, through prayer, participation in the Eucharist, and by giving generously to the collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Pope Francis said, "This missionary mandate touches us personally: I am a mission, always; you are a mission, always; every man and woman is a mission. People in love never stand still: they are drawn out of themselves; they are attracted and attract others in turn; they give themselves to others and build relationships that are life-- giving. As far as God's love is concerned, no one is useless or insignificant. Each of us is a mission to the world, for each of us is the fruit of God's love. From eternity he has destined each of his children to share in his divine and eternal life."

Saturday 5pm Mass – Please note that the last day for the Saturday 5pm Mass at Port Severn will be next week October 27th. After next week, Saturday Mass 5pm will resume on May 3rd, 2020 next year.

Voting as Catholics 2019 Federal Elections (by Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops) Voting is a Right and Responsibility.
