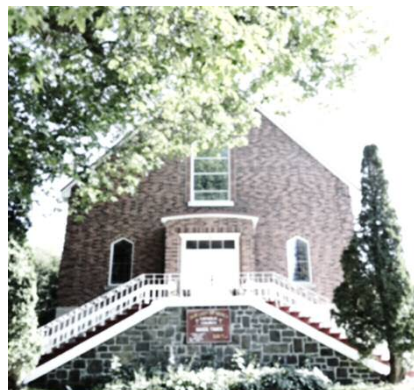

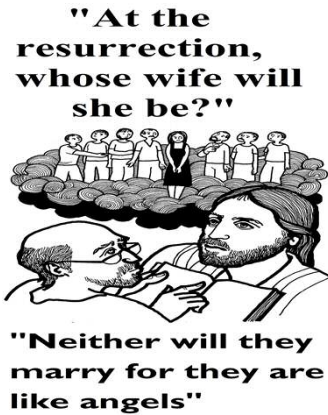

GOSPEL TODAY Luke 20:27-38: "The Sadducees do not believe in the resurrection of the dead. To justify their belief, they make marriage a scenario as seeing the resurrection, or life in the hereafter a continuation of life on earth. Jesus' answer indicates that there is a complete break between our present life and the resurrected life: the children of this world marry; but the resurrected do not. Jesus tells the Sadducees that their question is pointless, since in the next world everything is different. Death and reproduction no longer exist."

PRIESTS STUDY DAY – All pastors of the diocese of Peterborough will be attending an annual Study Day starting Tuesday, November 8 to Thursday, November 10 at the Nottawasaga Inn in Alliston. Please say a prayer for the success of our study day.

POPE FRANCIS - On All Souls' Day and throughout the month of November, the Church makes a special effort to remember, honor, and pray for the dead. In his homily, pope Francis said that All Souls' Day is a good occasion to ask if our desires have anything to do with heaven. He warned that there is a continual risk to put the expectations of the world before the expectation of God and to end up losing sight of what matters. "The best careers, the greatest achievements, the most prestigious titles and awards, the accumulated wealth and earthly gains, all will vanish in an instant, everything," he said.

POPE'S PRAYER INTENTION FOR NOVEMBER (For children who suffer)

"We pray for children who are suffering, especially those who are homeless, orphans, and victims of war; may they be guaranteed access to education and the opportunity to experience family affection." "There are still millions of boys and girls who suffer and live in conditions very similar to slavery. They aren't numbers, they are human beings with names, with a face of their own, with an identity that God has given them, the pope said."

PHILIPPINES TYPHOON NALGAE – "The recent tropical storm affected over 3.9 million people, damaged 499 roads and 120 bridges, and caused power outages in many areas. Tens of thousands more have been evacuated or fled their homes following severe floods and landslides. Nalgae (Typhoon Paeng, local name) is the 16th tropical cyclone to lash the Philippines this year. The Philippines is one of the most disaster-prone countries globally, mainly due to its location in the Pacific Ring of Fire and the Pacific typhoon belt. On average, the archipelagic country experiences 20 typhoons yearly, some of which are intense and destructive."

UKRAINE - "Churches are rushing emergency aid to Ukraine amid deadly Russian missile strikes continue across the country. Missionaries are also supporting churches to ease the human suffering of the ongoing Russian invasion of Ukraine by providing heat, hope, and millions of meals."

CHURCH TEACHING/POSITION (On Veneration of Images) "The Councils of Trent and Nicaea II state: "The images of Christ, the Virgin Mother of God, and other saints are to be held and kept especially in churches, that due honour and reverence are to be paid to them, not that any divinity or power is thought to be in them for the sake of which they may be worshipped, or that anything can be asked of them, or that any trust may be put in images, as was done by the heathen who put their trust in their idols, but because the honour shown to them is referred to the prototypes which they represent, so that by kissing, uncovering to, kneeling before images we adore Christ and honour the saints whose likeness they bear." The "Catechism of Christian Doctrine" by command of the Catholic bishops sums up the whole Catholic position exactly: "It is forbidden to give divine honor or worship to the angels and saints for this belongs to God alone. We should pay to the angels and saints an inferior honour or worship, for this is due to them as the servants and special friends of God. We should give to relics, crucifixes and holy pictures a relative honour, as they relate to Christ and his saints and are memorials of them."
