

PENTECOST - On Pentecost Sunday, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, they were granted the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Those gifts helped them to fulfill their mission to preach the Gospel to all nations. For us, too, those gifts—granted when we are infused with sanctifying grace, the life of God in our souls—help us to live a Christian life.

The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord. **The fruits of the Holy Spirit:** love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, long-suffering, mildness, faith, modesty, self-control, and chastity. After Christ's Ascension into Heaven, the Apostles knew that He had promised to send His Spirit. Granted the gifts of the Spirit at Pentecost, they were emboldened to speak the Good News to all men. On that first Pentecost Sunday, over 3,000 people were converted and baptized.

BIBLICAL QUOTES ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT - "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope" (Romans 15:13). "No one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:3).
