MEET YOUR NEW PASTOR

Father Orchard's call to the priesthood was neither sudden nor dramatic, but a slow process of formation that began after his Grade 9 year when he attended a Charismatic Renewal Conference. The weekend event was held at Varsity Stadium on the University of Toronto campus and attracted some 14,000



faithful. "Before the conference, I was a typical young person questioning my faith and beginning to drift away," he says. "The Sunday Mass was a beautiful outdoor celebration. Somewhere, deep in my spirit, I knew there was a God who loved me. It was a profound experience. After completing high school, he spent a year with the National Evangelization Team. There, he met Father Bob Bedard, who had founded the Companions of the Cross in Ottawa in 1985, an order based on the model of esus and the apostles. Priests, eminarians and young men considering the priesthood live together, pray together and support each other. Fr. Bedard invited him to come to Ottawa to live with the Companions and attend university. "I received the call to the priesthood during those years," he says. After earning an undergraduate degree in philosophy and religious studies, he entered St Augustine's Seminary in Scarborough where, during a third-year practicum in a parish, the call became clear and deep. "I said a full yes to God," Father Orchard recalls. "I hear you calling and I say 'Yes.'"

PASTORAL PLAN, Transforming our Lives; Building our Church, 2023-

2028 - A new Pastoral Plan will be launched today the feast of Pentecost. The Plan is the result of the conversations among religious, gatherings of the Deaneries and at the Diocese, parish meetings, committee work, lay organization discussions, a synodal process at area Catholic schools, and extensive online surveys over the past two years - all guided by the Holy Spirit. Many, many people contributed to this Plan. let's join together to support its implementation!

PENTECOST – "On Pentecost Sunday, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, they were granted the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Those gifts helped them to fulfill their mission to preach the Gospel to all nations. For us, too, those gifts—granted when we are infused with sanctifying grace, the life of God in our souls—help us to live a Christian life. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord. After Christ's Ascension into Heaven, the Apostles knew that He had promised to send His Spirit. Granted the gifts of the Spirit at Pentecost, they were emboldened to speak the Good News to all men. On that first Pentecost Sunday, over 3,000 people were converted and baptized. The example of the Apostles shows that the gifts of the Holy Spirit lead to the fruits of the Holy Spirit—works that we can only perform through the assistance of the Holy Spirit."

THE BIBLE, GOD'S WORD, is a Weapon. The devil was ultimately defeated over two thousand years ago at the Cross of Jesus, yet God allows him to actively resist us as believers... all for God's purposes and for our growth and benefit. One of the most powerful weapons we have against the devil is the Word of God. Jesus exemplifies this perfectly in both Matthew 4 and Luke 4, where the devil tempts Him three times... each time failing, as Jesus strategically quotes the scriptures, directly confronting the temptation saying "It is written..." Finally, the devil, having been defeated by the truth of the written Word, leaves Him until a later time. In his epistle to the Ephesians, Paul spoke about putting on the "Armor of God" and uses the metaphor "The Sword of the Spirit" referring to the "Word of God". The scriptures are powerful as an offensive, as well as a defensive weapon, not to be trifled with or handled lightly.
